*Citizens to Preserve Black Hawk Park began in 1972 as a non-profit effort to preserve a historic part of the Quad Cities and to fight encroaching development.*

*Since that time, the foundation has been an active part of fundraising and volunteer efforts to maintain and promote the 208 acre Black Hawk State Historic Site and Watch Tower Lodge.*

*Construction of the lodge began with the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1934. Since then, the native limestone walls have been home to a museum, restaurant, lodge, and educational center.*



In 2007, Black Hawk State Historic Site was voted one of the Seven Wonders of Illinois.
